The East Range Police Department, providing Public Safety services to the cities of Aurora and Hoyt Lakes under the direction of the East Range Public Safety Board, is currently seeking a full-time Patrol Officer.

At full strength, the East Range Police Department consists of eight (8) sworn officers which include the Chief of Police, one FT School Resource Officer (SRO), two Sergeants and one K9 Unit. The patrol officers' work four consecutive shifts followed by four days off. The department currently offers an excellent compensation and benefit package determined by Law Enforcement Labor Services (LELS) Local No. 531. The 2024 hourly rate per LELS contract is \$29.36 to \$32.62 based on probation process and completion. LELS contract negotiations begin late 2024 for the 2025 contract agreement.

The successful candidate must be licensed by POST Board or eligible for licensing by the hire date. The desired candidate must be committed to community policing, team oriented with strong communication abilities and possess strong interpersonal skills. An Associates' Degree in Law Enforcement or related field, and a valid MN driver's license. Candidates must successfully pass each of the following components: oral evaluation, background investigation, psychological evaluation, and physical examination including drug testing.
