

Addendum to City of Hoyt Lakes Community Building  
Reservation Policy due to COVID-19 Pandemic and to Comply with  
State of Minnesota, Governor Tim Walz Emergency Executive Order 21-07  
Effective February 22, 2021

All reservations for the use of the Community Building must adhere to the following requirements:

- A. Masks and face coverings required.
- B. In all settings, ensure a minimum of six feet of physical distancing between households.
- C. Occupancy must not exceed 50 percent of the normal occupant capacity (130), which will be no more than 65 people.
- D. Develop and implement a COVID-19 Preparedness Plan in accordance with applicable guidance available at the Stay Safe Minnesota website (<https://staysafe.mn.gov>).
- E. Celebrations and receptions in venues. Venues may host private celebrations, receptions, parties, or other private events, including but not limited to those connected to weddings, funerals, life milestones (such as birthdays and retirements), family reunions, planned religious services, and other similar occasions if they develop and implement a COVID-19 Preparedness Plan in accordance with applicable venue guidance available at the Stay Safe Minnesota website (<https://staysafe.mn.gov>). These private celebrations, receptions, parties, and other similar private events must be limited to no more than 50 people and must not take place between the hours of 11:00 pm and 4:00 am if they offer food or beverages (including alcoholic beverages) for on-premises consumption or permit food or beverages to be consumed on premises.
