

Minutes of Special City Council Meeting
Thursday, June 6, 2019
City of Hoyt Lakes, Minnesota

1. The Hoyt Lakes City Council met in special session on Thursday, June 6, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. Those present: Mayor Chris Vreeland, Councilors: David Zins, Brian Ceglar, Roald Chip Holter; Absent: Councilor Daniel Popp. City staff also present: Rebecca Burich.
2. The City Council discussed three applications for EMT and EMT/Firefighter upon recommendation to hire by the Fire/Ambulance Department after successfully completing the required interview and physical agility testing. Motion by Councilor Zins, supported by Councilor Ceglar, to approve the hiring of Paul Carland as EMT and Amanda Klovstad as EMT/Firefighter contingent on the successful completion of the required City testing. Motion carried. It was discussed to keep the application of Autumn Locken for EMT on file until a point in time that she can fulfill the requirements of the position.
3. Moved by Councilor Ceglar, supported by Councilor Holter, to adopt Resolution 2019-011, "A Resolution Authorizing the City Clerk-Treasurer to File an Application with the State of Minnesota Management and Budget for the Purpose of Arena Ice System Replacement" (full Resolution on file with the City Clerk-Treasurer). Resolution adopted unanimously. It was discussed that Mayor Vreeland, Councilor Ceglar, Supervisor West and City Clerk Burich meet on Tuesday, June 11, 2019 at 3:00 pm to prepare the application which is due June 14, 2019.
4. Moved by Councilor Holter, supported by Councilor Ceglar, to approve a walking surface between the columbarium's at the Hoyt Lakes Cemetery, with a possible bench and flowers utilizing a contribution of \$1,000 from Paul Forlan, in-kind service from Mesabi Masonry and balance from the Cemetery fund. Motion carried.
5. Mayor Vreeland moved, supported by Councilor Zins, to set a special City Council work meeting on Wednesday, June 26, 2019 at 5:00 pm for the purpose of discussing, among other items, future of the Minnesota Iron Rangers, Mesabi East Youth Hockey concession agreement and request for early ice, staffing, EMS Director position, road projects, Minnesota Independent Wrestling promotion. Motion carried.
6. Moved by Councilor Ceglar, supported by Councilor Zins, to adjourn at 4:40 p.m. Motion carried.
