**City of Hoyt Lakes**

**ATTENTION: HOYT LAKES MEMORIAL CEMETERY OWNERS**

The following is an excerpt from the Hoyt Lakes Memorial Cemetery rules:

4. Statues and statuettes are not permitted unless they are used as planters. One planter with natural or artificial flowers is permitted. A wreath constructed of natural boughs, branches or leaves, is only permissible from November 1 to February 1. Vigil lights are permitted year round except the City will not be held responsible for any damage caused to them; solar lights will be considered vigil lights. Two of the following are permitted on the gravesite: planters, vigil lights, veteran's flag holders and religious and fraternal emblems and are to be placed at the topmost headstone. Vigil lights and wreaths are allowed from November 1 to February 1. No other items may be on the gravesite from October 15 to April 15 and will be removed by the City after October 15.
