

**City of Hoyt Lakes
Resolution 2022-004**

WHEREAS, the City of Hoyt Lakes has made a considerable investment in providing recreational opportunities as a method of helping to diversify the economy of the City of Hoyt Lakes, the area and the region; and

WHEREAS, the recreational trail system is an important and integral part of the diversification of the economy of northeastern Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the Ranger Snowmobile/ATV Club is seeking to purchase a CAT 279DC Ultra Skid Steer with an 80” utility bucket, 48” forklift attachment, and a 78” brush cutter attachment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hoyt Lakes has been a significant partner with the Ranger Snowmobile and ATV Club in development and maintenance of area recreational trails;

WHEREAS, the Ranger Snowmobile and ATV Club requests sponsorship for the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources 2022 Equipment Grant Application, allowing for the club to apply for funds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hoyt Lakes City Council agrees to sponsor said application at no cost to the city; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City will act as fiscal agent for the grant and appropriate city official(s) are hereby authorized to sign grant applications, agreements and reimbursement claims to the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources and other appropriate funding sources for purchase of the above listed equipment; and
