Resolution 2022-010**

A resolution **accepting resignation and declaring a vacancy on the Hoyt Lakes City Council.**

WHEREAS, Christopher Vreeland was elected as Mayor of the Hoyt Lakes City Council for a term ending on December 31, 2022;

WHEREAS, Christopher Vreeland has submitted a letter of resignation, resigning his seat as a Hoyt Lakes City Mayor, effective June 1, 2022;

WHEREAS, there is now a vacancy in the Mayor position previously held by Christopher Vreeland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Hoyt Lakes City Council, as follows:

1. The Hoyt Lakes City Council hereby accepts the resignation of Christopher Vreeland from the Hoyt Lakes City Council, effective June 1, 2022.
2. The Hoyt Lakes City Council hereby declares a vacancy in the Mayor position previously held by Christopher Vreeland as of June 1, 2022.
3. The Hoyt Lakes City Council will then proceed to fill said vacancy by appointment in accordance with the procedures set forth in Minn. Stat. Sec. 412.02.
