Resolution 2022-012**

A resolution **accepting resignation and declaring a vacancy on the Hoyt Lakes City Council.**

WHEREAS, David Zins was elected as Councilor of the Hoyt Lakes City Council for a term ending on December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, David Zins has been appointed to a non-compatible office as of June 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, David Zins is resigning his seat as a Hoyt Lakes City Councilor, effective June 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, there is now a vacancy in the Council position previously held by David Zins.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Hoyt Lakes City Council, as follows:

1. The Hoyt Lakes City Council hereby accepts the resignation of David Zins from the Hoyt Lakes City Council, effective June 1, 2022.
2. The Hoyt Lakes City Council hereby declares a vacancy in the Council position previously held by David Zins as of June 1, 2022.
3. The Hoyt Lakes City Council will then proceed to fill said vacancy by appointment in accordance with the procedures set forth in Minn. Stat. Sec. 412.02.
