

**City of Hoyt Lakes
Resolution 2023-003**

A Resolution authorizing execution of a limited use permit (LUP) between the City of Hoyt Lakes and the Minnesota Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, the City of Hoyt Lakes has made a considerable investment in providing recreational opportunities as a method of helping to diversify the economy of the City of Hoyt Lakes, the area, and the region; and

WHEREAS, the Ranger Snowmobile and ATV Club of Hoyt Lakes has expressed a desire and commitment to develop the Moose Trail; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hoyt Lakes is the fiscal agent for the Ranger Snowmobile and ATV Club in development and maintenance of area recreational trails; and

WHEREAS, part of the Moose Trail runs the right of way on the south side of State Highway 135; and


WHEREAS, the Ranger Snowmobile and ATV Club, and the City of Hoyt Lakes as fiscal agent, take responsibility for the construction, maintenance, and supervision of the Moose Trail.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hoyt Lakes City Council agrees to sponsor said trail at no cost to the city; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City will act as fiscal agent for the trail and take responsibility for the construction, maintenance, and supervision of the Moose Trail.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to sign the limited use permit between the City of Hoyt Lakes and the Commissioner of the Minnesota Department of Transportation.
