

**City of Hoyt Lakes
Resolution 2023-013**

A Resolution of Sponsorship for the Moose Trail.

WHEREAS, the City of Hoyt Lakes has made a considerable investment in providing recreational opportunities as a method of helping to diversify the economy of the City of Hoyt Lakes, the area and the region; and

WHEREAS, the recreational trail system is an important and integral part of the diversification of the economy of northeastern Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the Moose Trail is an extension of the existing recreational system which connects the City of Hoyt Lakes to the maintained trails to the south, west and north of the city; and

WHEREAS, the Moose Trail will result in effectuating a needed trail between the City of Biwabik and the Gilbert OHV Recreation Area; and

WHEREAS, the Ranger Snowmobile and ATV Club of Hoyt Lakes has expressed a desire and commitment to develop the Moose Trail; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hoyt Lakes has been a significant partner with the Ranger Snowmobile and ATV Club in development and maintenance of area recreational trails;

WHEREAS, the Moose Trail has received a National Recreational Trail in the amount of \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the Ranger Snowmobile and ATV Club requests sponsorship of the Moose Trail, allowing for the club to apply for funds under the Minnesota Trail Assistance Program, also known as Grant-In-Aid Program for a period of 5 years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hoyt Lakes City Council agrees to sponsor said trail at no cost to the city for 5 years from the date of this resolution; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City will act as fiscal agent for the trail and appropriate city official(s) are hereby authorized to sign grant applications, agreements and reimbursement claims to the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources and other appropriate funding sources for construction, maintenance and administration of said trail; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appropriate city official (s) are hereby authorized to sign all easements, licenses or other instruments associated with the trail; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution is contingent upon the Ranger Snowmobile and ATV Club subscribing to a general liability policy similar to that which covers St. Louis County sponsored Grant-In-Aid Trails, and naming as additional insured on said general liability policy, the landowners over whose lands this additional trail traverses and the City of Hoyt Lakes.


