**WHEREAS,** David Zins was elected as Mayor of the Hoyt Lakes City Council for a term ending on December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, David Zins is resigning his seat as Hoyt Lakes City Mayor, effective June 1, 2024; and

- 3. The Hoyt Lakes City Council will then proceed to fill said vacancy by appointment in accordance with the procedures set forth in Minn. Stat. Sec. 412.02.
- 4. The Hoyt Lakes City Council will solicit applications for Mayor from current Councilors to fill the Mayor position.
