

City of Hoyt Lakes Resolution 2024-010

A resolution **accepting resignation and declaring a vacancy on the Hoyt Lakes City Council.**

WHEREAS, David Zins was elected as Mayor of the Hoyt Lakes City Council for a term ending on December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, David Zins is resigning his seat as Hoyt Lakes City Mayor, effective June 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, there is now a vacancy in the Mayor position previously held by David Zins.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Hoyt Lakes City Council, as follows:


1. The Hoyt Lakes City Council hereby accepts the resignation of David Zins as Mayor of the Hoyt Lakes City Council, effective June 1, 2024.
2. The Hoyt Lakes City Council hereby declares a vacancy in the Mayor position previously held by David Zins as of June 1, 2024.
3. The Hoyt Lakes City Council will then proceed to fill said vacancy by appointment in accordance with the procedures set forth in Minn. Stat. Sec. 412.02.
4. The Hoyt Lakes City Council will solicit applications for Mayor from current Councilors to fill the Mayor position.
