A resolution **governing the counting of write-in votes for local elective office.**

WHEREAS, the City of Hoyt Lakes is generally authorized to govern write-in votes for local elective office pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 204B.09 subd. 3;

WHEREAS, the City of Hoyt Lakes requires write-in candidates to file a written request on the form issued by the Clerk's Office with the City Clerk no later than the 7th day before the city election if the candidate wants to have the candidate's write-in votes individually counted.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Hoyt Lakes, Minnesota as follows:

Candidates are required to file a written request on the form issued by the Clerk's Office with the City Clerk no later than the 7th day before the city election if the candidate wants to have the candidate's write-in votes individually counted.

Adopted by the Hoyt Lakes City Council this 24th day of June 2024.


