

**City of Hoyt Lakes  
Resolution 2026-008**

Resolution Authorizing Submission of LCCMR ENRTF Proposal  
ML 2027 Environmental and Natural Resources Trust Fund (ENRTF)

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hoyt Lakes seeks \$1,156,000 in Environment and Natural Resources Trust Fund (ENRTF) funding to complete the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) Regional Trailhead Pavilion Restoration and Trailhead Development Project at Colby Lake in Hoyt Lakes, Minnesota, a capital construction project restoring the 1939 CCC Pavilion, improving ADA accessibility, enhancing environmental stewardship, and strengthening regional trail connectivity and year-round outdoor recreation access; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Hoyt Lakes City Council supports the above referenced project and authorizes the submittal of a proposal for funding of this project on behalf of the City of Hoyt Lakes to the Legislative-Citizen Commission on Minnesota Resources (LCCMR) in response to the ML 2027 Environmental and Natural Resources Trust Fund (ENRTF) Request for Proposal; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that, if funding is awarded, the City of Hoyt Lakes agrees to accept the award and may enter into an agreement with the State of Minnesota for the above referenced project. The City of Hoyt Lakes will comply with all applicable laws, environmental requirements, regulations, and any additional conditions stated in the grant agreement and the approved LCCMR work plan; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City of Hoyt Lakes understands that grants from the ENRTF are generally paid out on a reimbursement basis. The City of Hoyt Lakes has the financial capability to pay for project expenses prior to seeking reimbursement; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City of Hoyt Lakes certifies that none of its current principals have been convicted of a felony financial crime in the last ten years. For this purpose, a principal is defined as a board member or staff that would have the authority to access or determine the use of ENRTF funds, if awarded; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Mayor of Hoyt Lakes is hereby authorized to execute such agreements and work plans as necessary and City Administrator Dean Weiberg is authorized to implement the project on behalf of the City of Hoyt Lakes; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City of Hoyt Lakes has the financial capability to ensure adequate operation and maintenance of the project once completed; and


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that, if funding is awarded, the City of Hoyt Lakes may enter into an agreement, as approved by the State of Minnesota, for the ML 2027 project titled, “2027-380: Hoyt Lakes Civilian Conservation Corps Regional Trailhead,” and the City of Hoyt Lakes will comply with all terms as stated in the fiscal agent agreement.
